Report of one day seminar on The Goa Land Development and Building Constructions Regulations 2010

The Institution of Engineers (India), Goa State Centre in association with Institute of Town Planners, India-GRC and Town and Country Planning Department, Government of Goa, has organized a one day Seminar on The Goa Land Development and Building Constructions Regulations 2010, to deliberate on the existing regulations and formulate the suggestions for better procedures and clarity on the interpretation of various provisions.

The Seminar was held on 2nd July 2016 at the Multipurpose Hall, Central Library, Panaji. From 9AM to 6PM.

Around 180 nos delegates including members of the Institution of Engineers, Institute of Town Planners, Indian Institute of Architects, CREDAI, Valuers and other professionals involved in the process of Land Development and Building Construction attended the seminar.

Dr. S. T. Puttaraju, Chief Town Planner showed the willingness of the department to accept any suggestion / recommendation which will help to simplify / revise the existing building regulations. During the Question - Answer Sessions, he answered most of the queries, issue of interpretations asked by the delegates.

Chief Minister of Goa, requested all the stake holder Engineers, Architects, town Planners, Builders to come together towards better planning and sustainable development in Goa. He also requested officials of Town Planning Department to help Goan people during approval so that they can build their houses without any difficulties.

Thomas D'Costa, Convenor of the seminar while thanking the Institute of Town Planners, GRC, and the Town and Country Planning department for theirs association and support towards this seminar, emphasized the need for all the stake holder like Engineers, Architects, Builders, Valuers and professional to come together and work positively towards revision and improvisation of the existing building regulations with their experts suggestions and recommendations towards planning of better Goa.
