It is indeed a proud privilege for me to address

Friends, as you are aware, the Goa sub-centre of The Institution of Engineers (India) started on 27th September 1974 under the Chairmanship of Shri B.R.Naique, the then Chief Engineer of PWD. Goa, Daman & Diu.

In 1987, Goa Sub-centre was upgraded to Local Centre when the membership of the centre was around 200. AMIE examination started in Goa in 1988 for students appearing at the section A and section B Examination.

From January 1997, the Local centre started publishing Bulletin. This Bimonthly Bulletin provides information to its members about various activities of the centre and also publishes technical articles of general interest.

From December 2008, Goa Local Centre was upgraded to **State Centre** when the membership of centre was around 800.

The State Centre celebrates Engineers' Day, every year. On this occasion, various technical activities are arranged. In the past years, various eminent Engineers have been felicitated. The activities of the State centre are on the rise. In the recent years several seminars, workshops and paper reading sessions have been organized. 

Mr. Agnelo Gomes, Director of Gemini Motors made the arrangements to explain all the sections with the help of their staff...

The students saw the maintenance of the gearbox and differentials of Ashok Leyland trucks. They were briefed about the way the defects are identified and procedure for servicing. Another interesting aspect was the

incorporation of mechatronic elements for servicing and also the wheel alignment and balancing checking. Also students saw the working of Scantol a device which checks if the sensors on any engine part like fuel injector or valves are malfunctioning and hence they can detect the defects without any overhauling or disassembly saving lot of effort and time. Also the various sensors
