Dear Corporate Members,

It is informed that the Council at its 691st Meeting held on 25-26 Sep 2016 at Haridwar has decided that the candidate who desires to contest in the elections of The IEI shall deposit the following non-refundable earnest money:

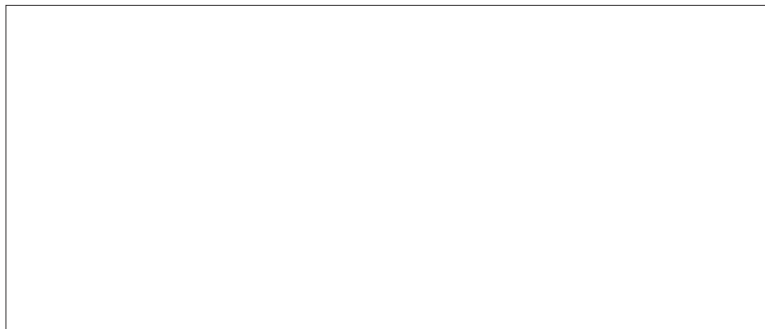
